Summary:

Concrete Form Carpenters - Form Carpentry Experience Required.

Concrete Finishers - Must Be Experienced.

Skilled Laborers - Some Construction Experience Required.

Performs all concrete forming duties and or finishing of concrete, for commercial construction as assigned by performing the following duties. Looking for skilled personnel at this time.

Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

1. Operates power tools in a safe manner to include table saws, radial arm saws, miter saws, skill saws, table and hand planers and drills.*

2. Adheres to established policies and procedures paying special attention to safety regulations.*

3. Set the forms that hold concrete to the desired pitch and depth, and align them.

4. Consolidating, compacting, edging, jointing, and grooving of concrete.

5. Spread, level, and smooth concrete, using rake, shovel, hand or power trowel, hand or power screed, and float.

6. Mold expansion joints and edges, using edging tools, jointers, and straightedge.

7. Apply hardening and sealing compounds to cure surface of concrete, and waterproof or restore surface.

8. Must be able to access work areas that are accessible by ladders, stairs, or under construction equals of limited access.

9. Read and interpret plans, instructions, and specifications to determine work activities.

10. Position, join, align, and seal structural components, such as concrete wall sections and pipes.

11. Verify correct measurements and specs for each work order.

12. Performs general concrete laborer duties including stripping and dismantling forms.
